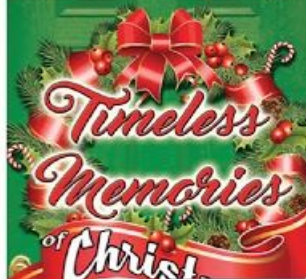

## 40 DAYS FOR LIFE

Our fall campaign for 40 Days for Life will begin on September 27 and end on November 5. We will be praying on the sidewalks surrounding the abortion mill at 14001 E. Stroup Rd. daily from 7:00 AM until 7:00 PM. We also have planned to have individuals there reading the Scriptures continually each day.

VCC members have been given the responsibility to have 2 individuals for prayer in one hour increments from 10:00 AM until 1:00 PM (109-111, 111-112, and 112-11) on Thursdays during the campaign (September 28, October 5, 12, 19, 26, and November 5). Consequently, we will have a total of 48 one hour slots to fill over this 40 day period. You may not believe that your presence and your prayers at this facility are important, but trust that they are absolutely critical to the success of defending life. Each and every one of us must stand and take action against this atrocity of death that surely brings Jesus to tears.

Please make a difference. Commit at least one hour of your time (or more...perhaps an hour each week) to stand in faith. Sometimes just your presence alone could lead a mother to reconsider the choice she is making. Your participation is vital. You will not be asked to interact with any of the mothers coming to the facility; only the sidewalk counselors take that task on. Also, the environment surrounding the mill is perfectly safe for you. (Only the mothers and their babies are not safe!)
